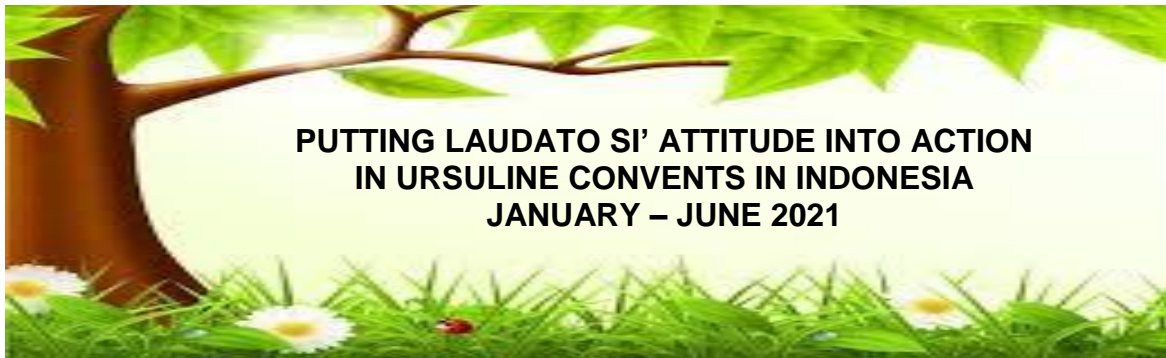




## THE URSULINE JPIC COMMISSION OF THE INDONESIAN PROVINCE
