

NEWS FROM THE HOUSE OF ST ANGELA, LE GREZZE

JUNE 2024



2 June: monthly meeting of the Friends of Saint Angela. This time, after a reflection on listening to the Holy Spirit and adoration, we took some time to evaluate our meetings of this year and to hear a report on the meeting of the Friends of St Angela at Fano.



6 June: this week a group of Associates of the Ursulines from France were making a pilgrimage in the footsteps of Saint Angela. With them were four sisters, including Sr Marie Bénédicte Moyrand who had spent three years in the community of Le Grezze. On the morning of 6 June, they visited the centre of Desenzano. Then we joined them for lunch at the "agriturismo", Mirabello.



Afterwards we spent the afternoon at Le Grezze: visit of the house, reflection on the life of Saint Angela at Desenzano; the life of the Holy Family and the family of St Angela; and a prayer on the names of Jesus used by Saint Angela.



Some of the Friends of Saint Angela from Desenzano joined us for refreshments. Finally, we visited the Church of St Angela and were all present for the parish Mass.



7/8/9 June: on all three days we participated in the parish festa.



9 June: a group of young people from the Ursuline school at Poznań, Poland, arrived in Italy for a week of pilgrimage to Desenzano, Brescia, Assisi, Roma, Monte Cassino and Venice. They began the week at the house of Saint Angela and they attended the parish Mass. They were accompanied by two sisters and three teachers.



17 June: three weeks of GREST (Group for summer activities) began in the parish.



22 June: Sr Paola Angeli, Ursuline FMI of Verona, came with a group of sisters from Madagascar and Peru.

23 June: a group of teachers and four sisters from the Ursuline school at Lublin, Poland, arrived in Desenzano on 21 June for a week. On Sunday, they visited the house and participated in the parish Mass in the evening.



28 June: this afternoon a group arrived from Zagreb, Croatia - 2 Ursulines and 43 Friends of Saint Angela with their parish priest. They celebrated Mass in the chapel and visited the house. After visiting the church of Saint Angela, they left for the lake and then to Brescia.
