27 February: we were happy to welcome Sr Anna Rosa Porro for a week. She was present also for the meeting of the Friends of Saint Angela.

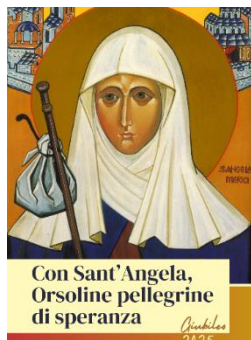
2 March: meeting of the Friends of Saint Angela: as usual we had a talk, adoration, sharing and some refreshments.

This is a Cammino in the area of Brescia with stops in the places associated with Brescian saints and blessed. After the filming (with some brief contributions from us) they stayed for a while to talk and take a coffee.





9 March: we participated in the on line conference "Saint Angela pilgrim of hope in the Holy Land, on the roads of the world" organized by the CIM as part of the programme for the jubilee year.

20 March: a visit of a group from the "réseau méricien", principals and those responsible for pastoral care in the Ursuline schools in France and Belgium. After a reflection on Saint Angela as a woman of hope and of peace, they had a time for personal prayer and then sharing and a prayer together in the chapel.
